The **GREATER PATERSON OIC** has implemented a program titled **STRIVE TO DRIVE** that has been a service to its community for over ten years, **helping** individuals with obtaining their Drivers Permit/License. Along with enhancing our customers knowledge of the rules of New Jersey's Roads/Highways.

What is STRIVE TO DRIVE

STRIVE TO DRIVE is a two week course, where we prepare our customers for the **NEW JERSEY MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSIONS (NJMVC)** Permit Examination.

During this two week period the customer will be tested on materials related to all facts and terminology used in the New Jersey Driver Manual. Driver Manuals are provided for all customers enrolled in **STRIVE TO DRIVE**.

Upon completion all enrollees will take a final examination before existing, to measure knowledge/information obtained from course.

Who is eligible for STRIVE TO DRIVE

The **STRIVE TO DRIVE** program is open to (**TANF**) "*Temporary Assistance for Needy Families*", (**GA**) "*General Assistance*" and (**Walk-ins**) "General Population/Community".

However for all **Walk-ins** there will be an out of pocket expense for the course.

How can STRIVE TO DRIVE benefit me

Overall, this program can be beneficial to that person, who has never had their driver license and has been seeking employment only to be deterred from an employment opportunity due to not having his/her driver's license.

STRIVE TO DRIVE will assist him/her with eliminating that obstacle/barrier, once the customer has obtained their driver license creating a marketable individual for New Jersey's workforce.
